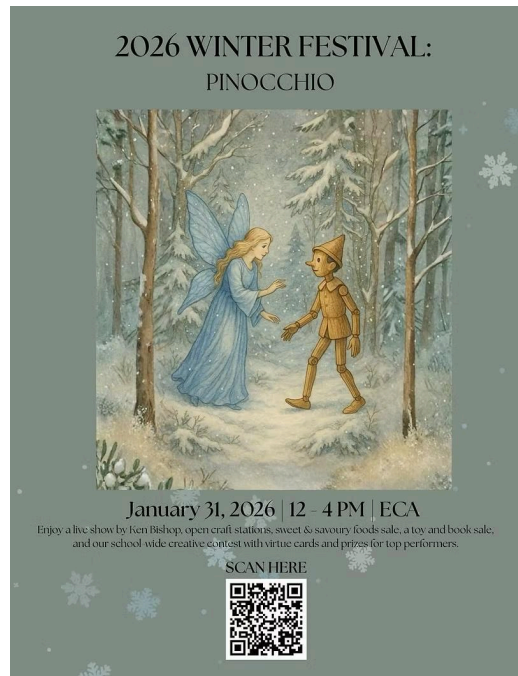

Healthy Hunger

Healthy Hunger is an **online lunch-ordering program** that turns school lunches into a simple, sustainable fundraiser for our school. Families pre-order meals from approved local restaurants and vendors, which are delivered directly to the school on designated days. Parents order and pay online in advance, and a **portion of every meal purchased is returned to the school**, creating consistent fundraising revenue. It's a win for everyone: schools receive ongoing financial support for student programs, families get convenient, kid-approved meals, and local restaurants gain meaningful community partnerships.
